

Recommendation to the President-elect of AOFNMB

Prof. Gang Huang

President of Shanghai University of Medicine and Health Sciences

Prof. Gang Huang is former president of Chinese Society of Nuclear Medicine (2012-2015) and current Dean of Asia Oceania School of Nuclear Medicine since 2013. Under his leadership, the Asia Nuclear Medicine Campus in China, Korea, and Japan was launched in 2014. More than 50 young physicians, nuclear medicine technologists and nurses were accepted to foster next generation nuclear medicine professionals in the region. Prof. Gang Huang launched Asia Nuclear Medicine Academic Forum to encourage research activity of nuclear medicine science. Nuclear Medicine Rising Professionals Competition was started in 2016 to create a platform for their communication and networking. All these activities promoted human resource development of nuclear medicine professionals and practice in the region.

In 2016 during the first ANMAF, we declared Shanghai Manifesto for Nuclear Medicine under the leadership of Prof. Gang Huang as follows;

Nuclear Medicine should not be limited to only **medical imaging** but also include **radionuclide therapy**.

Nuclear Medicine should not be limited to only SPECT & PET but march towards **Hybrid Molecular Imaging**.

Nuclear Medicine is a **safe medical approach** with low radiation exposure. It is patient, medical staff and environment friendly.

The Shanghai Manifesto is the principle of Nuclear Medicine in the region.

Prof. Gang Huang now organizes the 13th Asia Oceania Congress of Nuclear Medicine and Biology and welcomes all members of AOFNMB here in Shanghai.

Based on his contribution, leadership, and passion, I recommend Prof. Gang Huang to the President-elect of the Asia Oceania Federation of Nuclear Medicine.
